India is the author of the *Kama Sutra*. The people are not prudish but there are boundaries. There's a group culture and there's a bedroom culture. I don't think family values and the wholesomeness of ordinary Indians has changed.

I moved to Australia in 1972 and proudly tell my Indian friends and family I live on the Gold Coast. I believe God has made home here. My husband is from Melbourne and they're a little bit snobby about the Gold Coast but I don't have a cultural cringe.

I DOUBT such pictures will have any significant positive or negative impact on the success of the Gold Coast to attract tourists from India. Seeing or knowing about the pictures, Indians will have a chuckle. Nothing else.

Recent Bollywood movies and access to worldwide media in India have changed Indian society quite a bit. India today is not what it was a decade or two ago.

India, generally, is a socially conservative society but things are changing at a rapid pace. Increasing numbers are open-minded and aware of the customs and mores of other countries. Pictures like these are not a big deal any more, at least for those who are educated and upwardly mobile. Indeed, they are arguably the very segment of the Indian population that travels overseas for holidays and business opportunities, hence the perfect target for Gold Coast tourism.
